Emergency shoe removal courses

If you found your horse with a shoe half pulled, unable to walk comfortably and without causing further injury, would you be equipped and capable of removing the shoe and making the situation safe?

The ability to safely and quickly remove a shoe from a horse can save injury, stress and potentially money.

This 2hr course involves a short presentation on scenarios and methods for dealing with the unexpected, then a hands on session using a 'Blacksmith buddy'. (No live horses to get bored!)

Each participant will get to have a go and watching everyone else helps remember the process. I will show you how to stand safely and to use the tools correctly. Feedback from previous courses shows that it is invaluable experience giving confidence for when it is needed most.

Ideal for yards, groups, equine students or individuals.

The course is designed for a maximum of 8 participants and toolkits can be bought separately to take home to be kept on the yard or in the trailer when traveling.
